

Hoo Tiang Boon is Assistant Professor and Coordinator of the Masters in Asian Studies Programme at the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS), Nanyang Technological University, Singapore. He holds a DPhil in International Relations from the University of Oxford. He is the lecturer of the Masters courses, *China's Foreign and Security Policy* and *Cross-Strait Relations*, at RSIS and supervises five PhD students (presently).

Dr. Hoo's latest books include: *China's Global Identity: Considering the Responsibilities of Great Power* (Washington, DC: Georgetown University Press, 2018); and *Chinese Foreign Policy under Xi* (ed.) (New York & London: Routledge, 2017). He has published or forthcoming articles in several peer-reviewed journals, including *Asian Security*, *The China Journal*, *Journal of Strategic Studies*, *Journal of Contemporary China*, *St Antony's International Review*, and *International Journal of China Studies*. Dr. Hoo has been involved in several diplomatic initiatives, including the Singapore-US Strategic Dialogue, the Singapore-France Dialogue on China, the Korea-Singapore Forum and the Network of ASEAN Defence and Security Institutions. Dr. Hoo was formerly a visiting fellow at the China Foreign Affairs University, a visiting scholar at the Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences, and a visiting researcher at the Shanghai Institutes for International Studies.
